

Playground equipment removal report

09 November 2023

OVERVIEW

The carousel had to be removed from the playground.

BACKGROUND

A report was received that the carousel had broken, 30 September 2023.

An inspection took place. The carousel was removed from the area. The area was cordoned off, and later the playground was closed as it was not possible to make the area safe immediately.

Works took place to make the surface safe, and the playground was reopened on 07 October 2023.

COUNCIL DECISION

- Whether to replace the carousel now using funds from the EMR or wait until sufficient funds have been obtained to undertake phase 2 of the playground repairs.

TO NOTE:

- There are sufficient funds in the EMR to replace the carousel – EMR has £16,651.97
- The static vehicles would need to be removed to allow enough space to replace the carousel. There are insufficient funds to replace the static vehicles.
