Playground tree report

OVERVIEW

The playground currently has mature trees around some of the borders.

The Council could consider starting to interplant with young trees.

BACKGROUND

There does not appear to be a wide variety of age of tree currently in the playground, which could lead to open areas when the current trees need to be removed.

Two whips (flowering cherry, rowan, silver birch) are available from the Woodland Trust, via Sustainable Leafield. These are due to be delivered to Sustainable Leafield in November.

The Council would need to plant the trees and provide suitable tree guards for use in the playground.

COSTS

- 1. Soil etc required for planting
- 2. Metal tree guard and support post TOTAL COST circa £50 per tree

BUDGET CONSIDERATIONS
