## OXFORDSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (CHADLINGTON PARISH) (20 MPH SPEED LIMIT) ORDER 20\*\*

NOTICE is given that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The effect of the order – in order to help improve road safety on local roads following concerns raised by the parish – is to introduce a **20mph speed limit** throughout Chadlington, replacing the existing 30mph speed limit in its entirety in the process, leading out to the following points:

- Chipping Norton Road a point 105 metres northwest of its junction with Mill End
- 2. Cross's Lane a point 90 metres northwest of its junction with Bull Hill,
- 3. Horse Shoe Lane a point 216 metres south of its junction with Bull Hill,
- 4. <u>Mill End</u> a point 20 metres west of its junction with the access to Barley Hill Farm,
- 5. <u>East End</u> a point 75 metres east of its junction with the access to Langston House.
- 6. <u>The unnamed road running westwards through Greenend</u> a point 100 metres southwest of its junction with the unnamed road to Lower Court Farm.

The Oxfordshire County Council (Chadlington Parish) (Restricted Roads) Order 2001 will be revoked/replaced as necessary.
